NOMINATIONS OF JURY MEMBERS FOR ISSF WORLD CUPS IN 2016

The ISSF has called for nominations of Jury Members for World Cups in 2016 – **applications are to reach the Shooting Australia (SA) office no later than 16 September 2015.**

The ISSF provides the following information:

Member Federations have been reminded that, as the resolution of disputes at World Cups must be conducted in the English language, those nominated must have a good command of the English language. They must also have a good knowledge of the latest version of the ISSF Rules and Regulations EDITION 2013 (Third Print, 01/2015).

The ISSF designates the Chairmen of all juries from the ISSF Committees and one member for each Jury from the nominations, the third person being nominated by the host nation. Therefore, it is important that the nominees are well practiced, and have previous experience of working on international Juries. As the Juries are small, and the programs are tight there is little opportunity for any leisure time.

Those nominated must be fit and have the stamina to be on the ranges from about one hour before the start of shooting until the conclusion of shooting for that day in the discipline to which they are assigned. A number of Jury Members nominated for World Cups in the past have not met these standards. In the interests of the ISSF and all its shooters, you are requested to consider these points carefully before nominating for Jury duty at the 2016 World Cups.

As you are aware, those officially designated as Jury Members will receive a refund of travel expenses (up to a maximum of €900), local transportation, food and accommodation.

Judges can be nominated for the following World Cups in 2016:

Shotgun

Nicosia, CYP (17 – 25 MAR 2016)
Baku, AZE (1 – 11 MAY 2016)
San Marino, SMR (2 –12 JUN 2016)

Rifle/Pistol

Bangkok, THA (1 – 9 MAR 2016)
Munich, GER (19 – 26 MAY 2016)
Granada, ESP (20 – 28 JUN 2016)

As nominations always exceed available places, each nation is allowed to **nominate only three judges for Rifle/Pistol/Classification and two judges for Shotgun, in all a maximum of five.** Nominations for more than five judges will not be accepted.

Opportunities may exist for individuals not selected as one of the two officials ISSF members of each Jury to attend as additional ISSF Jury Members providing those individuals meet their own cost. Note that it should be clearly indicated in the bold box at the bottom of the Application Form attached. One form is required for each nominated individual.

It is hoped to inform you of those selected during December 2015.
