

By Law #2 – Effective Date 15 December 2006

AUSTRALIAN CLAY TARGET ASSOCIATION INC. (“ACTA”)

SUSPENSIONS

1. ACTA Suspension By Law

This By Law was adopted by the Executive Committee of ACTA on 15 December 2006 under clause 28 of the Rules of ACTA.

2. Suspensions

- (a) Any suspension of a registered shooter by a State Association must be advised to the ACTA within seven days of the suspension being incurred.
- (b) Advice on suspensions incurred must be accompanied by the notification of the relevant rule or authority under which the suspension was imposed.
- (c) Suspensions under existing rules of the Association are automatically National suspensions provided always that the term of suspension is in keeping with the rule(s) under which the suspension was imposed.

3. Request by State Associations

Any request to the ACTA for suspensions incurred at State level, which are not specifically covered under the existing rules, to be extended to apply at National level must be accompanied by,

- (a) Details of the actions which incurred the suspension, including copies of documentary evidence made available to the State Body which imposed the suspension.
- (b) Advice of the relevant rule or authority under which the suspension was imposed.
- (c) Upon receipt of the required information the matter will then be addressed by the Management Committee, who having satisfied itself that the request is in order will recommend to the Executive Committee that National suspension be imposed.

4. Reciprocal Suspensions – Australia / New Zealand

Upon receipt of advice from the New Zealand Clay Target Association of the suspension of any person by that Association, such suspension shall be recognised in Australia by the ACTA.

The Executive Committee of ACTA may amend this By Law from time to time.
