

GUIDANCE FOR REQUIREMENTS FOR A CLUB TO AFFILIATE WITH THE AUSTRALIAN CLAY TARGET ASSOCIATION LTD (ACTA)

- 1. A Club must first seek the support of a Zone where applicable, and then the endorsement of the State Association.***
- 2. Without the appropriate endorsements, a Club will not be accepted as an affiliate member of the ACTA.***
- 3. To be accepted a Club must be a legally recognized entity, the most common form used by Clubs affiliated with the ACTA being an Incorporated Association, with their governing constitution registered with the appropriate authority within their State.***
- 4. When a Club first applies for affiliation it must provide a copy of their registered constitution. That constitution must support the Australian Clay Target Associations Objectives.***
- 5. When a Club is developing their constitution the most efficient way is to use the “Model Rules” for an incorporated Association in your State, and put the Purposes and Objectives listed below at the top of the document. That way your Club will comply with the ACTA requirements as well as the legislation within your State.***
- 6. The Club submission to the ACTA must include the following documents: The application, your constitution, and the signed annexure form agreeing to abide by the ACTA constitution and By-Laws.***
- 7. These documents will then be reviewed by the appropriate ACTA committee for final approval.***

CLUB PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES

The purposes and objectives of this association are:

- To provide a Club for the social enjoyment and competition of Clay Target Shooting Sports for members and visitors.***
- To provide instruction in the safe handling and use of firearms for recreation and competition.***
- To foster, promote, develop, and encourage all forms of clay target shooting endorsed by the ACTA.***
- To conduct competitions under the rules and regulations as provided by the ACTA.***
- To contribute to the improvement and development of Club members through coaching and training — to coach juniors, members and prospective members.***
