

## GLENN CUP – AUSTRALIA VS NEW ZEALAND – 50 TARGETS DOUBLE BARREL

When shot in Australia or New Zealand, the top five (5) scores over the Australian-New Zealand Points, Single Barrel, Double Barrel and Mackintosh events will comprise the Australian Team to contest the International Glenn Cup Competition. (Rule 3.11).

Both teams shoot at 50 targets per shooter, double barrel from 15m, to be recorded point score (used only in the case of a tied score).

Should scores still be tied a further five targets per shooter per team scored point score will be shot continuing until a winner is established.
