The match will be shot squad system, one target per lane before changing. Broken targets to count. Point score will be used to separate State Teams for final placings.

In the event of an absolute tie for first place at the completion of each State Teams Match, each member shall shoot an additional five (5) targets until a winner is declared.

A Woman, Junior or Veteran nominated in the Open team can also represent the Women's, Juniors or Veterans teams as well depending on state rules.

Teams: Teams will comprise of:

 (b) Ladies Team - 5 member (1 emergency to be named)
 (c) Junior Team - 5 member (1 emergency to be named)
 (d) Veteran Team - 5 member (1 emergency to be named)
 Each competing country shall determine the composition of their respective teams by the process of elimination.

Note: A shooter cannot represent two teams, he/she must declare before the event which team they are competing for. eg either Open or Junior, **not both**.

Qualification: Each team member to be a citizen of the country for which they are competing for at least the twelve months prior to competition.
