(c) Junior Team - 5 member (1 emergency to be named)
(d) Veteran Team - 5 member (1 emergency to be named)
Each competing country shall determine the composition of their respective teams by the process of elimination.
- Note:** A shooter cannot represent two teams, he/she must declare before the event which team they are competing for. eg either Open or Junior, **not both**.
- Qualification:** Each team member to be a citizen of the country for which they are competing for at least the twelve months prior to competition.
