

The 1976 Annual General Meeting of affiliated club delegates and representatives was to be held in the Conference Room of the Rivervale Hotel, Perth, Western Australia, commencing 8.00 p.m. on Friday, February 27, 1976.

The secretary would be available with the registers from 7.30 p.m. for delegate attendance recording.

Scrutineers to check each member club delegate before they sign the attendance register for their respective clubs.

As each delegate signs the register, the scrutineers issue him a set of serially numbered ballot forms for:

- (a) National President;
- '(b) Executive Committee for his particular State in accordance with the Articles.

Delegates then proceeded to the places for completion of the voting forms by secret balloting procedure, thence lodged the forms in the ballot boxes provided for each State.

AGENDA ITEMS included:

- 1. A recommendation from the Executive Committee that shooter annual registration fees be \$15.00 per shooter as from 1-1-1977 (as provided in Article 49
- 2. Motion from Australian Gun Club (Vic.) "That the monies, as held in ACTA Travel Fund, be transferred to a building fund and the one dollar from the annual shooter's subscription fee be also placed in such fund.
- 3. The election of seats on the Executive Committee from nominations received by the ACTA Secretary as provided for in the Articles of the Association.

Affiliated units of the ACTA are reminded that they are entitled to one delegate (Article 15) to represent their interests at the Annual Meeting. However, delegates can only be accepted providing the Association "Articles of Association" are complied with. This involves the completion of the necessary forms, namely "Acceptance of Membership" (Article 5 (a)), "Nomination of Representative" (Article 21) (in the case of a corporate club), or "Nomination of Delegate" (Articles 5 (c) and 16) (in case of an unincorporated club), followed finally by "Notice of Acceptance of Delegates". Official printed forms as applicable are obtainable from the ACTA office. It should be noted that nomination of a representative or member delegate can only be accepted providing all subscriptions and monies due by either the nominee or the club, to the Association, have been paid as provided for in Article 49.

It is also pointed out that where a representative or delegate has been appointed previously, and this has not been officially rescinded, the appointment as previously made will stand, until the Association is advised or instructed otherwise. In accordance with the Articles of Association, clubs cannot appoint a delegate other than on the prescribed form (letters are unacceptable).

It is suggested, and recommended that all shooters complete and sign the "Schedule A" amateur declaration — two copies were in the November publication, one for personal record to be retained by each shooter, the other is perforated for easy removal. It is preferable that this copy, which is required for ACTA records, is forwarded by your club secretary, with your registration fee.

Forms must be written in ink to be acceptable.

ACTA central records have now been updated and all shooters have been allocated a permanent five digit number which appears on his 1976 handicap/registration card with his name and address. This number will remain permanently to that shooter and clubs are asked, when forwarding any information on handicapping, class shooting or change of address, to show the number with the shooter's name.

1976 Handicap/Registration cards contain an extrafold this year to provide for ISU Trench and ISU Skeet shooting.

Each shooter, when registering each year should physically show to the club secretary his current state firearms or shooting licence and this licence number should appear on his club renewal form (ACTA form 60 which is retained by the club) each year. This is a

The programme for the Australian National Clay Target Championships for 1976 being conducted at the Perth Gun Club was fully published in December, 1975 ACTA Shooting News with the events to be conducted in the sequence of:

Wednesday, February 25 — Skeet over 5 layouts. Thursday, February 26 — Double Rise. Friday, February 27 — Grand Handicap. Saturday, February 28 — Double Barrel. Sunday, February 29 — Single Barrel. Monday, March 1 — ANZ Points.

Tuesday, March 2 — International Trap Teams' Match and Champion of Champions.

TO BE NOTED by all concerned that the firearms laws of Western Australia provide that all firearms coming into the State must be registered — Visitors' Permits 50 cents — preferably on contacting the first police station on entry. Those seeking to shoot game would need a West Australian Game licence and juniors of 14 years are acceptable.

The Australian Clay Target Shooting Rules as prescribed for competition within Australia by the

Australian Clay Target Association were contained within the November, 1975 publication of ACTA Shooting News.

A pocket-size handbook containing the Australian Clay Target Shooting Rules and the International Shooting Rules (updated) is available on demand by member clubs for their shooters for \$2.00 per copy. A gratis copy is being mailed to all member clubs.

Within the ISU rules section and for those to whom the headings are not completely clear, the principal language within the International Shooting Union is the English language and the words International Shooting Union (ISU) are derived from Union Internationale de Tir (UIT).

Separately within this publication are the results of the final eliminations at the Melbourne Gun Club on February 2nd to achieve the two trench and two skeet shotgun shooters who will represent Australia at the 1976 Olympic Games at Montreal, Canada. The information so published is all that is available at the time of going to press. Subsequently as further information is received from the Australian Olympic Federation, this will also be made available. Fares, uniforms, cartridges and accommodation of Australian Olympic contestants are usually provided by donations to the AOF plus grants from the Commonwealth Government.

The 1976 New Zealand National Championships are scheduled to be conducted at Christchurch during March 20-27, with the programme in the following sequence:

March 20 — Open shoot.

March 21 - \$2,000 Trophy Match.

March 22 - Single Barrel Championship.

March 23 — Single Rise Championship (as for Double Barrel).

March 24 — Mackintosh Qualifying Matches and Glenn Cup.

March 25 — Mackintosh Teams' Match and Sparrow Championship.

March 26 — Double Rise Championship and commence Skeet.

March 27 — Finish Skeet and shoot Australia v. New Zealand Skeet Teams' Match.

On February 10 it was announced by both the Victorian and New South Wales Governments that they each have changed the opening date of the 1976 Open Season for Wild Ducks to read March 13, repeat March 13 and the season will then remain open until probably May 31.

The change of opening date occurred because it clashed with the newly proclaimed Victorian State Election polling date as March 20.

Dear Mr Berry,

This year sees the Mount Isa Gun Club as hosts for the Queensland section of the 1976 Interstate Trap Teams' Match.

Mount Isa, for those who have not been there, is a city of some 32,000 population and is located approximately 1200 road miles north-west of Brisbane and approximately 600 miles west of Townsville. It is a city with a high standard of living and amenities, the equal of any similarly sized coastal city.

Accommodation for the visitor is first class, with a wide range of hotels, motels and caravan parks. Tourists enjoying staying in the "Isa". Some 73,400 people came through Mount Isa's airport in 1974 and there are approximately 25,000 visitors per year to the Mount Isa Mine.

Mount Isa Mines Limited is the free world's largest single-mine producer of lead, and the second largest producer of silver. It ranks sixth in zinc production and is among the top ten world producers of copper. The mine is one of the most highly mechanised in the world and has also one of the best safety records of the world.

Visitors may tour the surface operations of Mount Isa Mines Limited twice daily on week days and special permission has been obtained by the club for shooters and their wives to tour underground at the mine before and after the Teams' Shoot. Because of the work involved, the Company has set a date of April 1 for nomination for the underground tour only.

The club has two Damo and one Winchester electric traps and has been in operation since 1968. Some caravan accommodation is available on the gun club grounds.

We look forward to hosting the Queensland Section of the 1976 Interstate Teams' Match and extend an invitation to all shooters and their wives to visit Mount Isa in June 1976.



Final eliminations for Montreal Olympics

FINAL ELIMINATION for the selection of 2 Trench and 2 Skeet shotgunners for submission to the Australian Olympic Federation for acceptance into the Australian team for the 1976 Olympic Games at Montreal, Canada.

The weekend of January 31st and February 1st and 2nd saw the completion of final eliminations for the Montreal Olympic Games; the venue being the Melbourne Gun Club at Lilydale, Victoria. The weather, as is usual for Melbourne, was a little of all four seasons over the three days ranging from near 100° to a quite wintry morning on Monday, the 2nd of February.

It was encouraging to see the increase in qualified shooters from all parts of Australia at this particular elimination and indicates the growing interest in European International shooting by the country's shotgunners. This applies particularly to the younger shooters of whom many attended, for it is this group that Australia must depend on, in the years to come, to secure those very precious gold medals.

It may take some time before we are successful overseas because experience must be gained under difficult conditions; confidence must be gained through competing and a strict regard must be paid to both mental and physical fitness. All of this leads to the final requirement where a shooter knows he can cope with any conditions, and his mental attitude and physical ability are such that he reaches the desired state of mental-physical equilibrium which he must have to win.

A highlight of the 1st day was 100/100 by Jim Ellis from West Australia, a very fine effort and it was a pity he could not maintain this standard for the rest of the event.

Steady shooting by J. Porter of Queensland resulted in a tie for 1st place with that old experienced shooter Peter Wray of Melbourne and it was only after a shoot-off which ran to 50 targets that Peter finally edged in front. We are going to hear a lot more of this young shooter from the land of the pineapples.

The ISU Skeet elimination brought forth young John Summers Junior of Melbourne as an up and coming Skeet shooter of international standard and he finished up with the highest score of 283:300 for the whole event. Mark Little, also of Melbourne, shot well to come into second place.

Finally, those who may be interested to compete in the future should remember that shooting 300 targets over three days is both physically and mentally exhausting and the fittest man in both departments will be the winner.






Rear view showing the two toilets.


