

# Editor's Notes



Some time ago a list of affiliated member clubs was published for the benefit of registered shooters visiting the various member clubs and from popular demand for a repeat of such a list, each member club was mailed a questionnaire in September, 1975, with the request that the questionnaire be returned quickly.

Now, some eleven months later, although about ninety clubs have not managed to complete and lodge such a form, under authority of our national president, some of the contents of those forms as received are published herein for the benefit of travelling shooters.

All affiliated member clubs are listed but we are unable to publish the regular shoot dates or geographical situation of many clubs.

Some clubs have sought the method of conducting a high gun shoot-off over a program of varied events.

Trap Rule 98 states that in the event of a tie for High Gun, where such program includes varied types of events, the shoot-off shall consist of rounds of two of each TYPE OF TARGET on the High Gun program. Many clubs interpret the rule to read as rounds of two targets for each event but this is not correct. The shoot off, for a program consisting of one D.B. District Championship and five D.B. Handicap events would be two targets D.B. from 16 metres and two targets D.B. from handicap.

A club conducted a graded handicap event in which three shooters shared the 23 to 25 metre section and five shooters shared the 21 to 23 metre section.

The operative word in rule 149(a) is OVERALL in that the handicap formula applies "to all events subject to handicapping with the exception of handicap events in which there is an overall entry of less than twelve shooters and of any class of a common mark graded event in which there are less than four shooters."

Thus each of the shooters concerned was handicapped as the overall (or total) number of entries exceeded this minimum exclusion.

## "STOP PRESS"

"The gold medal for trapshooting (15-trap trench) at the 1976 Olympic Games at Montreal, Canada, was won by Dan Halderman of U.S.A. with a score of 190-200 broken targets — this is the lowest winning score on record in this section of the modern Olympics.

Australia's representative in this section of the 1976 Olympic Games was Peter Wray of Tullamarine Victoria. Peter gained 25th placing with a score of 173-200.

The present world record score for this event is 199-200 established in 1972 at Munich.



## Wad Seating Pressure

Wad pressure on AA Wads is not critical.

Any pressure from zero to 40 pounds is acceptable — the only criteria is that the wads must be seated on the powder. (No air space should exist between wad and powder.) A safe level to use is 20 lbs.

## 10 Commandments for Reloaders

- Never load in haste — avoid distractions.
- Never smoke whilst handling powder or primers.
- Handle primers carefully.
- Store powder in a cool dry place.
- Never use a powder you cannot identify.
- Never mix powders.
- Never exceed recommended loads.
- Keep powder and primers out of the reach of children.
- Store powder only in its original container.
- Develop a loading routine to avoid mistakes.
